

During the summer months, Elevate Youth focuses on maximizing outside time.





Some may ask...what's next after Elevate Youth? We are proud to introduce our *Leaders Program*: a teen development program designed for high schoolers who "graduate" from our middle school programs. Launching in summer 2023, we will invite highly motivated students into a one-year immersive program that focuses on outdoor education, internship opportunities, and sustainability projects. Participants will learn peer mentoring skills as well as become members of the EY Youth Council that will give voice to the Board of Directors. We are grateful to the Jack Murphy Foundation for supporting this program.

FISH ON!

Elevate Youth will serve as the fiscal sponsor for the FishOn! program with the mission to amplify the social and emotional well-being of kids living in urban environments by connecting them to nature through an exceptional local fishing experience. Youth and families of EY'S partners as well as youth from new community partners will be able to take part in this initiative. FishOn! will utilize the Boston Harbor & freshwater ponds within the city limits to facilitate local fishing outings. This program is in partnership with the Massachusetts Department of Fish & Wildlife, Massachusetts Department of Marine Fisheries, and Costa Sunglasses. We look forward to introducing over 100 kids to fishing in 2023 & are honored to take part in the growth of this exciting program.
